Qualifications and Experience

Responsibilities

- Plan and conduct volunteer orientation sessions, communications, and engagement activities.
- Work closely with staff to identify volunteer needs and develop new volunteer opportunities.
- Motivate and manage volunteers, volunteer formation, and volunteer projects.
- Build relationships with volunteers, recognize their contributions, and create opportunities for feedback and ongoing engagement.
- Coordinate volunteer schedules, match volunteers with appropriate mission work, and provide support as needed. Ensure volunteers understand their roles and responsibilities.
- Maintain accurate volunteer contact information and records.
